

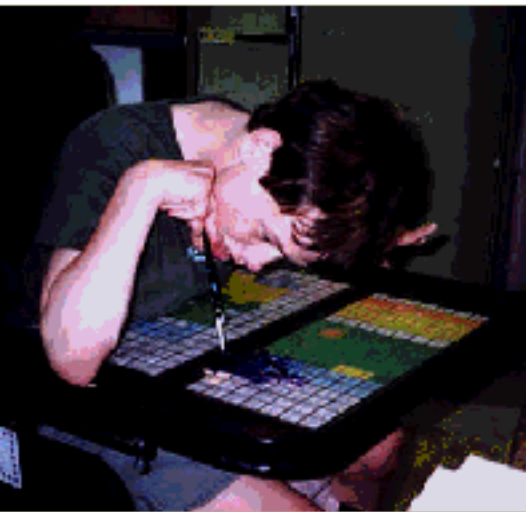
A GREAT WEEK OF HOLIDAY FUN!

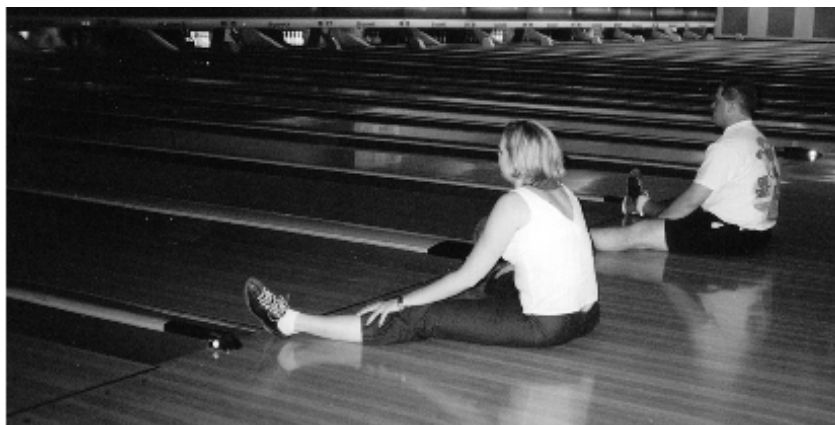

On Wednesday June 19, camp just happened to be celebrating "Christmas" when Channel 7 ABC News came up for a day to visit and learn about our organization. Reporter Kevin Roy and his cameraman Derek were greeted by several Horizon members and given the grand tour. For the next several hours, they learned about the Association of Horizon, Inc. and were able to experience camp, possibly the only way to truly understand it, **by visualizing it with their own eyes.**

As Kevin Roy wrote in his news story, "**At Camp Horizon able-bodied and disabled campers come together to form what some of them call a week of paradise or Utopia.**" They say at the camp, located north of Chicago in Lake Villa, is the closest they come to feeling completely normal and accepted in society." Kevin continues to state, "Many campers say it's hard to put in words the special magical thing that happens over the course of the week, but the goal of this camp is to break stereotypes of the disabled. Life is no picnic for any of these people, but for one week out of the year everyday is a holiday at Camp Horizon."

ACCESS MATTERS EVENT

To celebrate the **12th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act**, Inclusion Solutions held an event on Tuesday morning, July 23rd to generate awareness of the law and to help business owners understand the benefits of providing access to customers with disabilities. They gave 50 business owners in Lincoln Park (Halstead and Armitage) the gift of access by installing their product, the BigBell, at 50 locations.

When business owners arrived, they found the BigBell temporarily mounted on their business and also a gift box on their doorstep containing an ADA Reference Guide, additional information on Inclusion Solutions and details on a three-month study in which they are asking them to participate.

The study will track the economic impact of customers with disabilities when a neighborhood takes steps to improve access. At the end of three months, they hope the data will show that access really does matter, and makes good business sense.



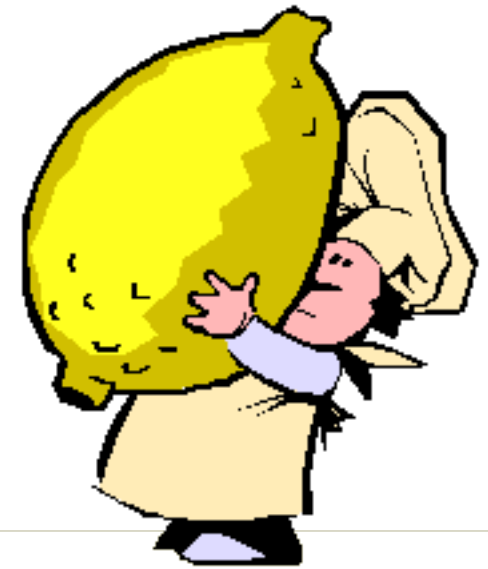
