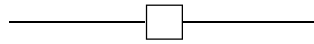
## NEW HORIZON BOARD

## Night at the Races

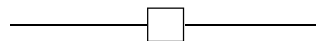

## Kiwanis Club



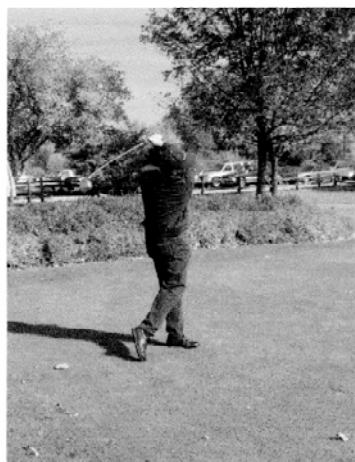

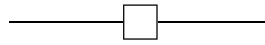

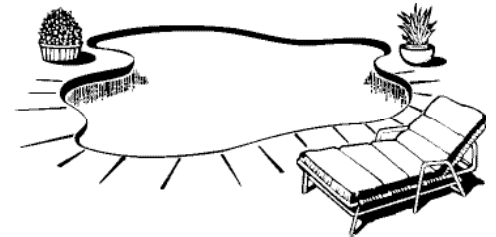
## CAMP HORIZON 2006



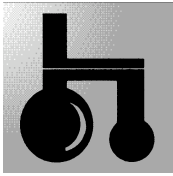

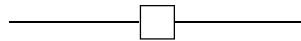
