Dear Friend of Horizon,

The Association of Horizon, Inc. (Horizon) will be hosting its **Annual Summer Camp Program** July 21-27, 2019. Horizon is a Chicago-based not-for-profit organization that provides a summer camp for adults with physical disabilities each year as well as a variety of monthly activities such as a fall weekend camp, all-day shopping trip, and holiday party. All of these activities not only provide opportunities for adults with and without physical disabilities to socialize, interact, and learn from one another, they also help Horizon spread disability awareness.

The focus of Horizon Camp is to provide an opportunity for people with and without disabilities to interact and challenge themselves by working together and learning from each other. Our camp is unique because each adult with a disability (camper) is paired with at least one person without a disability (volunteer) to provide personal care and companionship for the week. For many campers and volunteers, this week of camp is the first time they are able to participate in activities such as boating, swimming, fishing, campfires, performing arts, and educational workshops. The independence that campers experience at camp is then carried over into their everyday lives. For volunteers, Horizon Camp is a life-changing experience and after a week of selflessly caring for an adult with a disability, volunteers leave camp with a new awareness of disability and often become advocates for people with disabilities.

Horizon hosts up to 110 adults with physical disabilities each year. At approximately \$1,000 per camper, the total projected cost is \$110,000. This includes the campsite rental, medical equipment rental, insurance, supplies, activities, and food. In order for Horizon to keep this *free of charge for all participants*, we depend on generous companies and individuals. It is our hope that you will join them.
